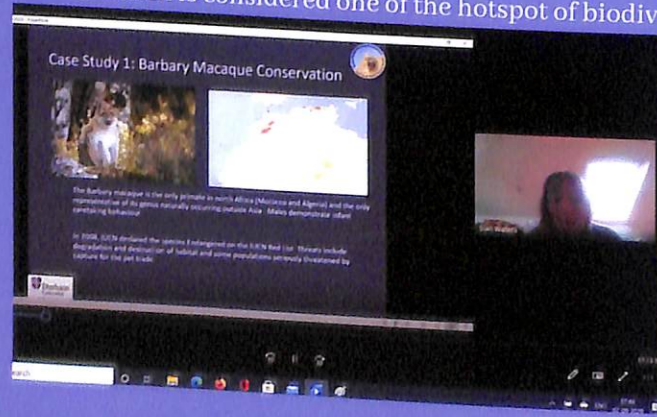

## International Webinar on "Why Studying People is key to understanding Human Primate Interaction"

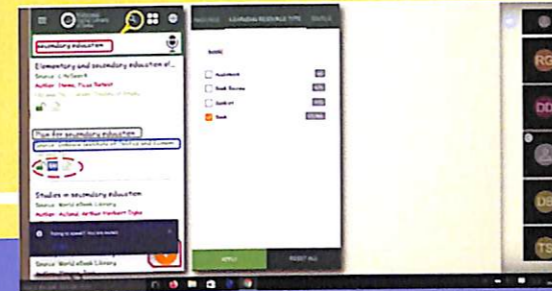

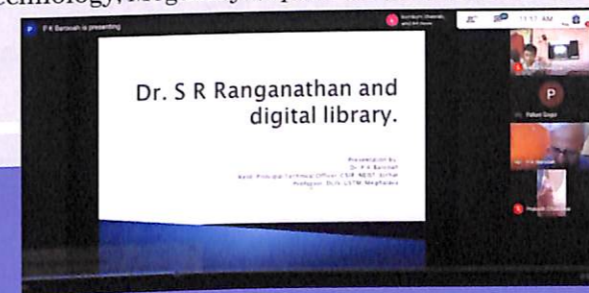
## Awareness Programme on National Digital Library of India

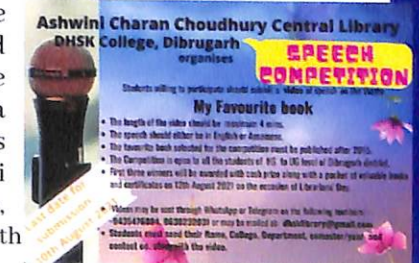


## Beyond Books: libraries as tools for social change

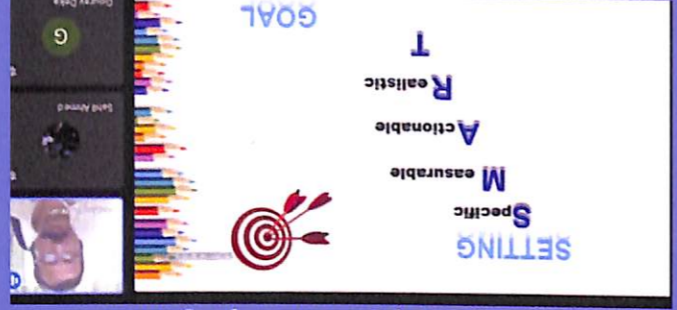


## Talk on 'Power of Visualization to achieve goal'

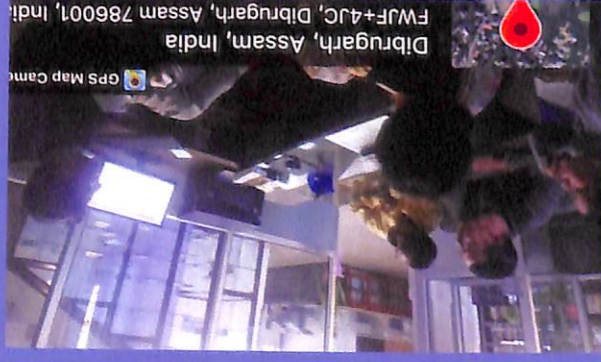

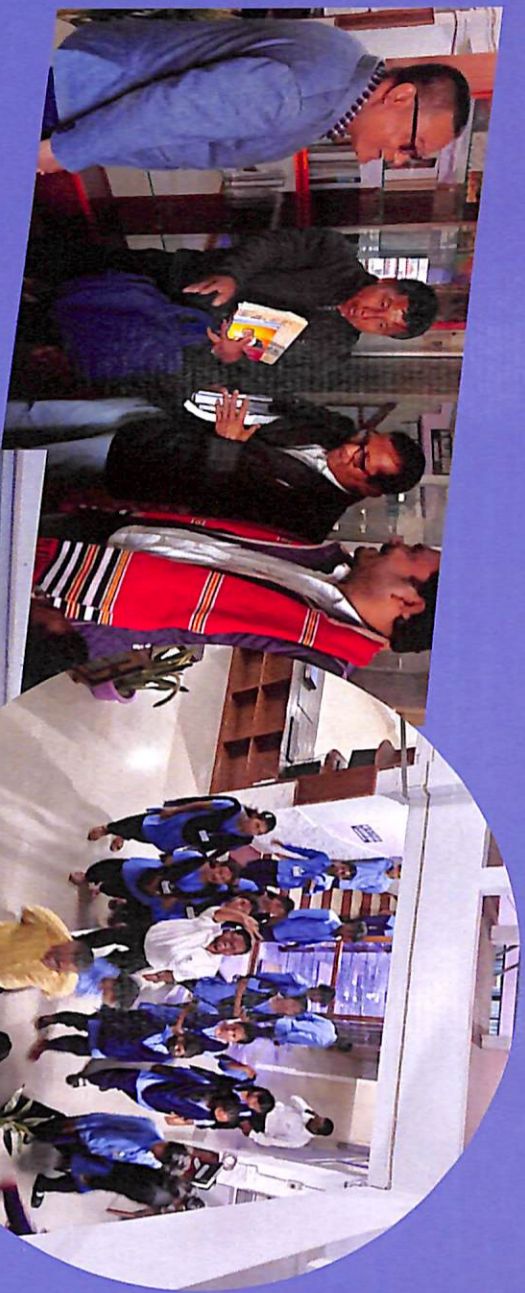


Our library provided assistance to the library staff of Pithubar Girls' Degree College in the use and application of SOL software.
