
## Awareness programme on Open Access E-Resources



Ashwini Charan Choudhury Central Library organised an online awareness programme on 5th June 2020 for its students to make them aware of open access e-resources




## International Webinar on "Why Studying People is key to understanding Human Primate Interaction"


## Awareness Programme on National Digital Library of India


## Web talk on Relevance of Dr. S R Ranganathan in digital environment




## Beyond Books: libraries as tools for social change




